Registration procedure	<p><b>Registration for students in a two-year technical program or master's program:</b> Students in a class must complete registration as a whole. All students in the class have to give their Campus Cards to the class monitor on the registration date, and the class monitor will take the Campus Cards to the Registration Division on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the instructional building to complete the registration procedure. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Please use the payment slip mailed to you by Ming Chi and make payment via ATM, at any branch of Hua Nan Bank or the post office, or by credit card before the deadline required for each program. 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	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Upon staying in Taiwan for 6 months, an international student has to pay the national health insurance premium in the amount of NT\$749 per month. Ming Chi will receive 6 months' premium from the student upon registration every semester. (The insurance premium from September to February of the next year shall be received in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester, while the premium from March to August shall be received in the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester.)</li> </ol>

2. Path for preliminary course registration: Homepage→Student Course Registration System→Guidelines for Course Registration→Student Number and Password→Check the courses to be registered
3. A student extending the study term has to pay student accident insurance premium in the amount of NT\$133. If the credits for the courses taken by the student are 9 or fewer, the student needs to pay NT\$1,278 per credit pursuant to the payment standards. If credits are 10 or more, the student has to pay tuition and miscellaneous fees in full. (The payment slip is available online. Please print it out and make the payment.)
4. Failure to make required payments may result in punishment in accordance with the rules of the school. After payment, please have your Campus Card stamped by the Registration Division, which is located on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the instructional building. A student extending his/her study term has to pay attention to the courses that s/he is required to take and has not yet taken (and whether any two of these courses that have to be taken have overlapping times).
